Sendai International Airport Opens New Passenger Boarding Facility on October 28, 2018!

*- New Flight Information Display System and expanded event area on the first floor
will provide better customer experience -*

Sendai International Airport Co, Ltd. is pleased to announce the opening of our new passenger boarding facility on October 28, 2018. Along with this new facility, upgraded new Flight Information Display System (FIDS) and expansion of the event area will offer more convenient and comfortable customer experience to customers.

1. New Passenger Boarding Facility

With our corporate mission of increasing the number of visitors to the Tohoku Region and contributing to revitalizing the local economy, Sendai International Airport has been working on various projects since it started to operate as the first privatized national airport in Japan. As part of the efforts to achieve this mission, the new passenger boarding facility was built with independent investment of the private company.

The new facility is connected to the west side of the existing passenger terminal building. By increasing the number of departure boarding gates for domestic flights from 6 to 10, the airport capacity will be increased particularly during the peak time, such as in the morning and in the evening, when the largest number of flights are in operation. As a result, a new environment that can handle new routes and additional capacity was achieved to better respond to customers' needs. With this capacity expansion, it is anticipated that Sendai International Airport will be able to accommodate the company's passenger goal of 5.5 million by 2044.

2. Flight Information Display System Upgrade

With the opening of the new passenger boarding facility, the flip-panel flight information board will be replaced with the new Flight Information Display System (FIDS) utilizing digital signage starting on October 28, 2018. The new system was installed at 34 locations throughout the airport and will deliver real time information including gate changes in four languages such as Japanese, English, Chinese (simplified and traditional) and Korean.

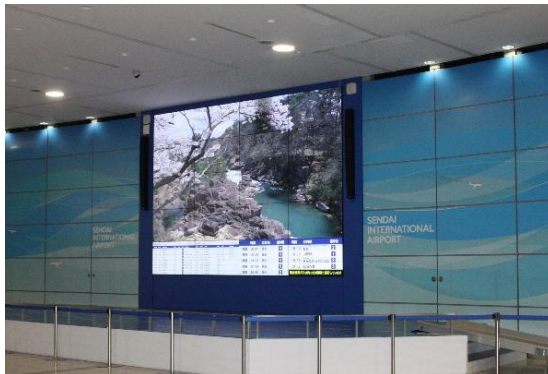

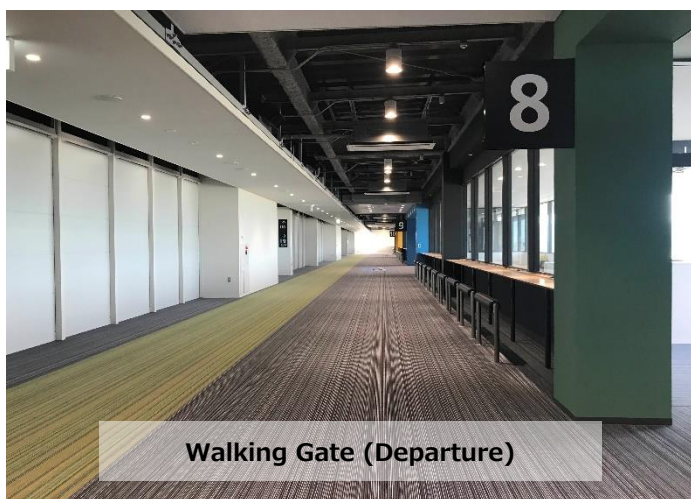

【Outline of the Pier Building】

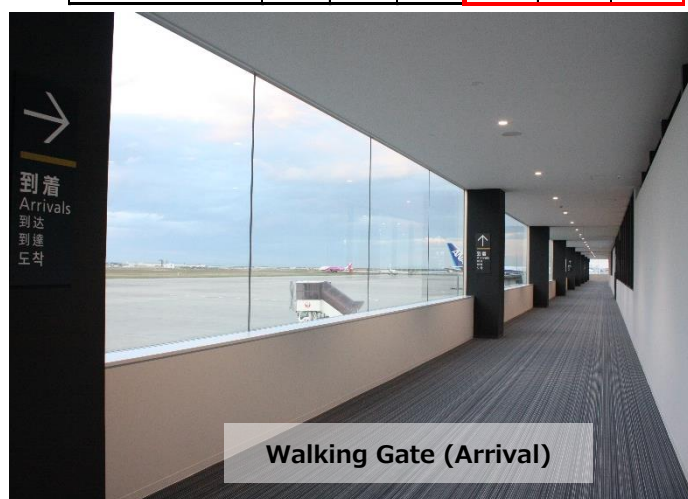

Sendai International Airport Co., Ltd., a seven-company consortium, started the operation of Sendai International Airport from July 1, 2016. This marked the first case of a private sector take over of the operation of a government-owned airport, bringing functions previously conducted separately by the central government, local government, and quasi-public corporations under a single operator (with the exception of air-traffic control).
